
## MPM 18 TALYLLYN RAILWAY Co. GUARDS BRAKE & LUGGAGE VAN No.5



Brake van No.5 was built by Brown, Marshall & Co. Ltd in 1866. The vehicle was used for the carriage of luggage and small goods as well as providing the only braking method on passenger trains. Originally built with a veranda end, this van was progressively altered into its present-day form. The kit provides sufficient parts to build one of the many variations to the modellers chosen time period from 1866 to the early 1950's.

The kit features full detailed sides and ends with external framing and planking, doors, guards lookouts, booking office ducket and many other small details-moulded roof, interior partition and fully detailed under frame with brake gear, lost-wax brass correct pattern side buffers, brake column and 8mm spoked wheels. Comprehensive building instructions with suggested variations included.
